

“Rapid Transition to Active Membership” Provisional Course

The objective of the “Rapid Transition to Active Membership” Provisional Course is to transition you into active membership in only six months. During the course, you will learn about the structure of The Junior League of Abilene and participate in several exciting projects that serve the children of Abilene and Taylor County. **If you successfully complete the course requirements, you will be accepted into active membership in The Junior League of Abilene.**

The requirements of the “Rapid Transition to Active Membership” Provisional Course are:

1. Attend all **four** “Rapid Transition to Active Membership” Meetings to be conducted in May, June, July, and August;
2. Attend all **five** General Membership Meetings including “The May Dinner” in May and monthly meetings in August, September, October, and November 2010;
3. Complete **two community service hours** by volunteering on any of the community projects;
4. Complete **two PAVE service hours** by volunteering on any of the PAVE projects;
5. Fulfill your **\$75.00 Money Raising Obligation (MRO)** by purchasing tickets for any of the 2010 Christmas Carousel events;
6. Complete **four service hours** by assisting either the 2010 Christmas Carousel Auction Committee or the Decorations Committee before Christmas Carousel;
7. Complete **8 services hours** during Christmas Carousel;
8. Attend a meeting of Teen Court, the Abilene City Council, the Board of the Abilene Independent School District, or the Board of the Wylie Independent School District and file a report with the Provisional Chair;
9. Complete additional service hours as may be necessary; and,
10. Attend The Junior League of Abilene Fall Placement Interviews and request your first placement as an Active member.
